Humber: Hull Frontage Improvements

Victoria Dock Village information event

The Environment Agency is hosting a public information event to provide residents with more information about our work planned at Victoria Dock Village.

The event will be held on Monday 03 December 2018 at Victoria Dock Village Hall, South Bridge Road, Victoria Dock, HU9 1TL from 12:30pm to 7pm.

This is an opportunity for residents to look at our latest plans and designs for the Victoria Dock Village area and discuss these with the project team.

We will also be seeking feedback from residents about our designs for this area.

What is the scheme?

The Humber: Hull Frontage scheme is a £42 million flood defence scheme to upgrade the tidal flood defences along the Humber edge of the city of Hull.

The scheme will reduce the risk of flooding from the Humber Estuary to 113,000 properties.

Contractor BBM JV – a joint venture between BAM Nuttall and Mott MacDonald - has been appointed to develop a detailed design and build plan along Hull's tidal waterfront.

Current update

Subject to planning approval, work on the Humber: Hull Frontage scheme will start in early 2019 and be complete by the end of 2020.

A planning application was submitted to Hull City Council in August 2018.

The Main Road

After a very long wait and a lot of talking the Roger Millward Way / Plimsoll Way / Great Union Street island work has started.

The only bit that is unfortunate is that the cross hatched lane going east is not to be used. It would have been so much more useful.

We are told that Myton Bridge is not good enough to take traffic spread fully across the carriageway.

The works should make traffic flow much better and along with the new footbridge will aid flow. Once the Mytongate junction is changed vehicles will flow from Victoria Dock through to the Clive Sullivan Way without stopping, The only thing to impede the flow will be broken down vehicles, large loads etc.

Myton Gate junction is to take maybe a couple of years once it starts which is not due yet.

The foot bridge at Prince's Quay will make crossing the road much safer for pedestrians and help traffic flow.

Slipway pond update
